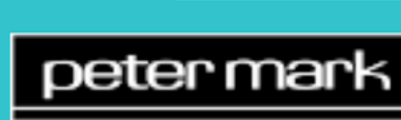

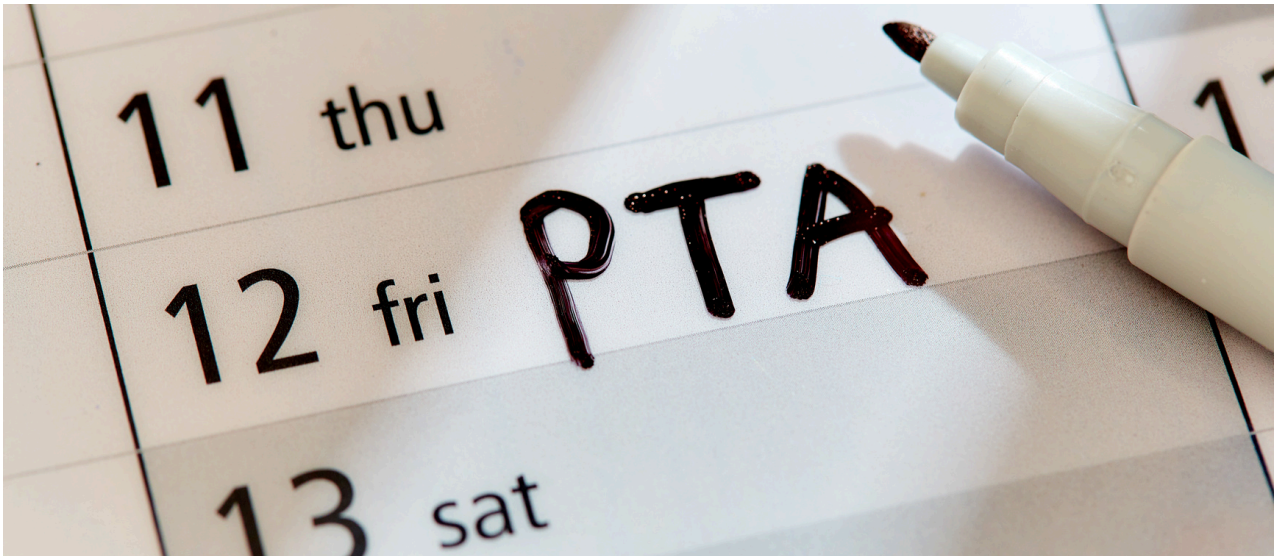
We are asking for donations of soft drinks and wine that we can give out at the event. A box will be left in reception for this. Many thanks.
